QUIZ BOWL RULES

1. The purpose of the quiz bowl is to educate the AJLA membership on various facts regarding the beef industry through a competitive event. The competition takes place during the annual ACGA summer convention.
2. The quiz bowl competition is open to any current AJLA member. Youth may join AJLA and **pay dues** at the time of the quiz bowl competition. Winner cannot win prize money if membership dues have not been paid.
3. Fact sheets will be emailed to AJLA members before the convention. This is why it is very important that the advisor has your current email each year.
4. Youth and Junior members are responsible for the **first half** of the quiz bowl facts. Intermediate and Senior members are responsible for **all** of the facts. Questions will vary in difficulty throughout the competition.
5. The quiz bowl teams will be arranged at the convention. The advisor will attempt to assign each member to his/her perspective category according to the speech contest age divisions, but reserves the right to reassign people to make sure every group has competition.
6. It is **imperative** that the bell is rung and the advisor calls upon the member before giving the answer. Those members who shout out the answer without ringing the bell will be ignored, thus possibly providing the answer to an opponent.
7. The AJLA advisor or designee will pose the questions and has the **FINAL** say in who receives the point.
8. The one who has the most points when the last question is asked will determine the winner of each division.
9. There will be a 1st place award in each division. Each winner will receive a ribbon and a monetary prize of \$10.
